

Easter Egg Colors

For this week's activity you are going to need hard boiled eggs (at least 8 per child) and the following food coloring:

- Green
 - Purple
 - Red
 - Black
 - Pink
 - Yellow
 - Orange
- 

You will want to leave one uncolored egg. As you color your eggs, you can talk your kids through the Easter story. Each color represents a part of Holy Week.

Green represents the palm branches at Jesus' procession into Jerusalem. Purple represents the wine that Jesus poured and blessed at the Last Supper. Red represents the blood that Jesus shed at the cross to rescue us from our sins. Black represents the sky at the moment of Jesus' death. Pink, yellow and orange represent the sunrise on the day that the disciples discovered that Jesus had risen from the dead. White represents the forgiveness for our sins and our new relationship with God through Jesus.
