

Craft #1 Yarn Swag Christmas Tree

Instructions

1. Felt your foam cone.
 - Using the stencil, trace and cut out a piece of felt that will wrap around your foam cone.
 - Hot glue the felt to the foam cone.
2. Pick out any yarn of your choice. We suggest a thicker yarn to make the tree look more full.
3. Cut out a long piece of yarn.
4. Starting at the base, make a small line of hot glue. Zigzag the yarn to form draping loops that hang down the tree. Glue only the top of the yarn to the tree so that the draping loops hang freely.
5. Continue this all the way around the tree.
6. Go up a couple inches and do the same process, making sure the bottom of the drapes cover the top of the lower layer and go all the way around the tree.
7. When you're done, inspect the tree for empty or scarce places. You can glue individual loops to the tree to fill in the empty space.

Craft #2 Pom Pom Christmas Tree

Instructions

1. Felt your foam cone.
 - Using the stencil, trace and cut out a piece of felt that will wrap around your foam cone.
 - Hot glue the felt to the foam cone.
2. Make your Pom Poms. (Or you can buy your Pom Poms online)
Different ways to make Pom Poms:
 - With your hands:
 - Wrap the string around your fingers several times. (The more fingers you use the bigger they will be. The more string you use the fluffier they will be.)
 - Cut a separate string and tie it around the loop you just made.
 - Cut each end where the loops are and fan out the strings.
 - With the Pom Pom maker:
 - Fan out each part of the maker and wrap the string starting at one end.
 - Move the string to the other end and wrap it around.
 - Close the circle and cut the attached string.
 - Tie the string around the circle and take apart the Pom Pom maker.
3. Hot glue the Pom Poms all over your cone. Use different textures, get creative and make it your own!
